

# BOYCOTT

## Charles Krug-Mondavi Wines!

Napa Valley vineyard workers at Charles Krug winery--operated for generations by the Peter Mondavi family--need your help. Krug-Mondavi just fired all its vineyard workers on the same day the state of California told the winery it was filing a formal complaint. The complaint says Krug-Mondavi has no right to refuse to bargain with its vineyard workers over renewing their United Farm Workers contract and has no right to fire the workers.

Please help these farm workers win back their jobs by calling Krug-Mondavi CEO Peter Mondavi at **800-682-KRUG** and express your distress. Tell Krug-Mondavi it is not above the law, that the company should immediately rescind its decision to fire these longtime workers who have given the winery years of loyal labor and that Krug-Mondavi should engage in good faith bargaining.

Let the company know you will spread the word about the farm workers' boycott of Krug-Mondavi wines, including Charles Krug Napa Valley, Charles Krug Family Reserve, and C.K. Mondavi wines.
